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
Instructions:

1. Cut out pattern below, including seam allowances and trace onto your fabric.

2. If you are making a double layered mask, (recomended), include for all seam allowances. If you are making a single layered mask, just use the front seam allowance.

3. Sew your pieces together, inside out, along the front seam line.

4. If double layering, repeat steps 1-3 and sew these together, inside out, along all seam lines, leaving one rear seam open to fold it all the right way out.
